8 TO PROCLAIM MARCH 2021 AMERICAN RED CROSS MONTH IN

13 TO PROCLAIM MARCH 2021 AMERICAN RED CROSS  
14 MONTH IN ARKANSAS.

16 WHEREAS, founded in 1881 by Clara Barton to serve people in need, the  
17 American Red Cross received the first congressional charter in 1900, and  
18 continues today with the task from the United States Government to provide  
19 service to members of the United States Armed Forces and their families and  
20 to provide disaster relief in the United States and around the world; and

22 WHEREAS, neighbor helping neighbor is one of the goals of the American  
23 Red Cross, and in the Missouri-Arkansas region alone, there are nearly three  
24 thousand (3,000) volunteers, over one hundred twenty-two thousand six hundred  
25 (122,600) blood donors, and twenty-five thousand (25,000) donors; and

27 WHEREAS, in the July 2019 to June 2020 fiscal year, the American Red  
28 Cross rendered emergency assistance to six thousand three hundred (6,300)  
29 people in need due to disasters; installed one thousand nine hundred (1,900)  
30 smoke alarms in seven hundred sixty-five (765) Arkansas homes; provided  
31 support to service members, veterans, and their families facing emergencies  
32 in four thousand four hundred (4,400) case services; trained sixteen thousand  
33 one hundred (16,100) individuals in first aid and other lifesaving skills to  
34 respond quickly in a crisis; and collected twenty-five thousand five hundred  
35 (25,500) units of blood and platelets to provide patients with lifesaving

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption of this resolution, an appropriate copy shall be provided to the executive directors of the Arkansas chapters of the American Red Cross by the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives.
