16	TO RECOGNIZE REPRESENTATIVE FRED ALLEN
17	FOR HIS INDUCTION INTO THE ARKANSAS
18	SPORTS HALL OF FAME AND FOR HIS
19	CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE STATE OF ARKANSAS.

21	WHEREAS, on April 14, 2023, Representative Fred Allen will be inducted
22	into the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame at the Statehouse Convention Center in
23	Little Rock, Arkansas; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, Representative Allen played basketball at Little Rock Central
26	High School and became the first African American tenth grader to become a
27	full-time starter on varsity; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, Representative Allen guided Little Rock Central High School to
30	two (2) state championships, a second-place finish, and an overall state
31	championship during his time on the basketball team; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, Representative Allen, averaged thirty (30) points per game
34	while at Little Rock Central High School, set an all-time high scoring record
35	of forty (40) points in one (1) game, and scored one hundred twenty-five
36	(125) points in four (4) games; and

2	WHEREAS, Representative Allen was selected All-Conference three (3)
3	times, All-State twice, became the first African American to earn a Most
4	Valuable Player award, played in the All-Star game, and was named to the
5	"Scouting Systems of America" All-America team in 1972; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, Representative Allen played basketball at the collegiate level
8	first at Western Texas College before transferring to Middle Tennessee State
9	University; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, Representative Allen led the Middle Tennessee State University
12	Blue Raiders in scoring his sophomore year and was voted Newcomer of the Year
13	and honorable mention All-Conference; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, Rep. Allen embodied the true definition of a student-athlete
16	and graduated with a degree in Business Administration and later served on
17	Middle Tennessee State University's alumni board,

19	NOW THEREFORE,
20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OR REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL
21	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24	Allen on his induction into the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame and thank him
