2	(b)(1) The Compressed Natural Gas School Bus Pilot Program is created
3	for the 2014 and 2015 fiscal years to provide compressed natural gas school
4	buses to four (4) public school districts.
5	(2) Each congressional district in the state may have one (1)
6	public school district participating in the program.
7	(3) Each school district in the state may apply to become a
8	participating school district in the program.
9	(4) If more than one (1) school district from a congressional
10	district applies to the program, the participating district will be selected
11	by random drawing from all qualified applicants submitted for a congressional
12	district.
13	((5) The Division of Public School Academic Facilities and
14 15	<u>Transportation shall run the program for its term.</u> (c)(1)(a) Each public school district participating in the program
16	shall be provided ten (10) compressed natural gas school buses.
17	(b) The school buses provided under the program shall be
18	purchased by the division based upon specifications and requirements
19	determined by the division.
20	(2) To qualify for the grant under subdivision (c)(1) of this
21	section each public school district seeking to participate in the program
22	shall submit an application in the form and manner established by the
23	division setting forth that the applicant:
24	(A)(i) Agrees to purchase ten (10) compressed natural gas
25	school buses, in addition to those provided under subdivision (c)(1) of this
26	section, before June 30, 2015.
27	(ii) The compressed natural gas school buses to be
28	purchased by the participating district shall meet or exceed:
29	(a) The specifications and requirements of the
30	compressed natural gas school buses provided by the division; and
31	(b) Applicable provisions of the rules of the
32	Commission for Arkansas Public School and Academic Facilities and
33	Transportation, as they existed on January 1, 2013;
34	(B) Either:
35	(i) Has reasonable access to refueling options to
36	allow for efficient use of the compressed natural gas school buses; or
37	(ii) Agrees, if the proposal calls for the

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1	construction of a new refueling station, to provide access to the refueling
2	station to the general public; and
3	(C) Has sufficient resources to purchase, operate, and
4	maintain the compressed natural gas school buses under this section,
5	including information demonstrating that purchase, operation, and maintenance
6	will not cause a financial hardship on the applicant.
7	(3) In addition to the requirements for qualifying applicants
8	under subsection (c)(2) of this section, the division is authorized to
9	develop and require compliance with additional qualifications it deems
10	necessary.
11	(d) The division may promulgate rules to administer the program.
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13	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-20-803 is amended to read as follows:
14	6-20-803. Loans to local school districts.
15	(a) The maximum amount of money a local school district may borrow
16	from the Revolving Loan Fund shall be five hundred thousand dollars
17	(\$500,000).
18	(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, a school district
19	participating in the Compressed Natural Gas School Bus Pilot Program under §
20	6-19-128 additionally may borrow up to one million five hundred thousand
21	dollars (\$1,500,000) for the purchase of new compressed natural gas school
22	<u>buses.</u>
