12 Joint Budget Committee meeting which report shall include the name of the  
13 Agency, Board, Commission or Institution and the amount of the funding  
14 carried forward, the program name or line item, the funding source of that  
15 appropriation and a copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;

16 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a  
17 written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
18 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written  
19 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for  
20 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)  
21 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents  
22 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget  
23 Committee; and

24 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall  
25 include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals  
26 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or  
27 Institution.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~  
29 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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31 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARY OF  
33 THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. It is the intent of the  
34 General Assembly that the appropriation for the salary of the Commissioner of  
35 the Department of Education shall be the sole and exclusive authority for his  
36 or her salary. It is further the intent of the General Assembly that the

1 Commissioner be required to devote all of his or her working time exclusively  
2 to the performance of his or her duties as Commissioner of the Department of  
3 Education. Therefore, the Commissioner of the Department of Education is  
4 hereby prohibited from accepting any additional salary from any other source  
5 (including state, federal, or private entities or persons) for the  
6 performance of his or her duties as Commissioner, and is prohibited from  
7 accepting any salary, fees or compensation from any other source (including  
8 state, federal or private entities or persons) for any other employment of  
9 any kind outside the scope of his or her duties as Commissioner, including  
10 but not limited to consulting work for any other public or private entity.  
11 This section shall not be construed to prohibit the Commissioner from  
12 accepting or receiving expense reimbursements and employee benefits as  
13 provided by State law.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~  
15 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

16

17 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
19 ESTABLISHMENT OF A "POSITION POOL". (a) To address needs emerging from  
20 statewide education issues and the necessity of recruiting and retaining  
21 qualified personnel, the Arkansas Department of Education or its successor  
22 agency is authorized for the ~~2018-2019~~ 2019-2020 fiscal year a pool of no  
23 more than five (5) ~~Professional/Executive~~ Information Technology positions at  
24 a salary not to exceed the maximum salary for a grade ~~N912~~ IT12. These  
25 positions are to be used by the Department of Education in the event that the  
26 personal services needs of the Department during the ~~2018-2019~~ 2019-2020  
27 fiscal year require additional positions, either by title or in number, that  
28 are not authorized by the General Assembly in the Regular Salaries section of  
29 this Act. These positions may also be used to properly classify positions  
30 when the Department does not have a vacant position available with the  
31 appropriate title and salary level.

32 (b) To address needs emerging from statewide education issues and the  
33 necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Arkansas  
34 Department of Education or its successor agency is authorized for the ~~2018-~~  
35 ~~2019~~ 2019-2020 fiscal year a pool of ten (10) ~~classified~~ General Salaries  
36 positions at up to a grade ~~G130~~ GS15. These positions are to be used by the

1 Department of Education in the event that the personal services needs of the  
2 Department during the ~~2018-2019~~ 2019-2020 fiscal year require additional  
3 positions, either by classification or in number, that are not authorized by  
4 the General Assembly in the Regular Salaries section of this Act. These  
5 positions may also be used to properly classify positions when the Department  
6 does not have a vacant position available with the appropriate title and  
7 grade level.

8 (c) Any salary determinations or adjustments administered under the  
9 provisions of Subsections (a) and (b) of this Section shall be made by  
10 comparing the qualifications and salary levels of similar employees in school  
11 districts or in other state education agencies.

12 (d) The Department of Education is authorized to access the pool  
13 positions authorized in this Section at any time when it is determined by the  
14 Commissioner that the need exists. The Commissioner shall provide a monthly  
15 report of the justification for the need to allocate titles from this growth  
16 pool to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative  
17 Council or Joint Budget Committee for review. The report shall also include  
18 an accounting of the names, titles, and salaries of personnel whose salaries  
19 have been adjusted under provisions of Subsections (a) and (b) of this  
20 Section.

21 (e) If the Department of Education requests continuation of any  
22 "Position Pool" position(s) as established herein during the next fiscal  
23 year, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in the agency's  
24 budget request.

25 (f) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency  
26 is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by  
27 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the  
28 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has  
29 determined that the Arkansas Department of Education could be operated more  
30 efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is  
31 being accomplished by providing a position pool in Subsections (a) and (b) of  
32 this Section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad  
33 powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate  
34 that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the  
35 position pool by requiring review of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
36 Committee in the utilization of the position pool. Therefore, the requirement

1 of review by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a  
2 severable part of this section. If the requirement of review by the  
3 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a  
4 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~  
6 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

7

8 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE  
9 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STATE FUND  
10 RESTRICTIONS. No state funds shall be used for abortion referral in public  
11 schools, or for abortion services. Funds shall be expended in accordance with  
12 Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-18-703.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~  
14 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

15

16 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
19 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

25

26 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
28 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
29 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34

35 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
36 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits

1 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
2 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of  
3 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
4 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
5 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm  
6 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
7 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
8 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
9 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
