4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-10-105(c), concerning the definitions for
5	the offense of negligent homicide, is amended to read as follows:
6	(c) As used in this section:
7	(1) "Fatigued" means:
8	(A) Having been without sleep for a period of twenty-four
9	(24) consecutive hours; or
10	(B) Having been without sleep for a period of twenty-four
11	(24) consecutive hours and in the state of being asleep; and
12	(2) "Intoxicated" means influenced or affected by the ingestion
13	of alcohol, a controlled substance, any intoxicant, or any combination of
14	alcohol, a controlled substance, or an intoxicant to such a degree that the
15	operator's reactions, motor skills, and judgment are substantially altered
16	and the operator therefore constitutes a clear and substantial danger of
17	physical injury or death to himself or herself or to another person <del>.</del>
18	(3) "Wireless interactive communication" means typing, text
19	messaging, emailing, or accessing information on the Internet with a handheld
20	wireless telephone; and
21	(4)(A) Handheld wireless telephone" means a wireless interactive
22	communication device with which a user engages in wireless interactive
23	communication using at least one (1) hand.
24	(B) "Handheld wireless telephone" does not include a:
25	(i) Hands-free wireless telephone or device;
26	(ii) Citizens band radio;
27	(iii) Citizens band radio hybrid; or
28	(iv) Global positioning or navigation device or
29	system.

31	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-10-105, concerning the penalties of
32	negligent homicide, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as
33	follows:
34	(d)(l) A court shall prepare and transmit to the Department of Finance
35	and Administration an order of denial of driving privileges for a person
36	within twenty-four (24) hours after the plea or finding, if the person:

1	(A) Pleads guilty or nolo contendere to negligent homicide
2	under subdivision (a)(l)(E) of this section; or
3	(B) Is found by the court to have committed negligent
4	homicide under subdivision (a)(l)(E) of this section.
5	(2) In a case of extreme and unusual hardship, the order under
6	subdivision (d)(l) of this section may provide for the issuance of a
7	restricted driving permit to allow driving to and from a place of employment
8	or driving to and from school.
9	(3) Upon receipt of an order under subdivision (d)(l) of this
10	section, the department shall suspend the person's motor vehicle operator
11	license for twelve (12) months.
12	(4) The penalty prescribed in this subsection is in addition to
13	any other penalty prescribed by law for negligent homicide under subdivision
14	(a)(l)(E) of this section.
