8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OFFICE OF HEALTH
10 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the Office of Health Information Technology, to be payable from the General
22 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Office of Health Information
23 Technology the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 1 of Act
25 130 of 2015, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of Health Information Technology
26 (OHIT), for the State Health Alliance for Records Exchange (SHARE), and for grants to rural or critical
27 access hospitals, in a sum not to exceed.....\$756,886.

29 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations
30 otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury
31 funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies
32 listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and
33 to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the
34 State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided
35 further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance
36 and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for

1 any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

2 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General
3 Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable
4 fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
5 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided
6 by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

7
8 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds
9 disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the
10 stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the
12 Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of
13 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that
16 the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year
17 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of the agency for
18 which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative
19 session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm upon
20 the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
21 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
22 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
