## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
10 HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN  
15 SERVICES - DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES  
16 REAPPROPRIATION.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES. There is  
23 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services, to be payable from  
24 the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Human Services -  
25 Division of Youth Services the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided  
27 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 360 of 2019, for maintenance of residential  
28 facilities, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,500,000.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided  
30 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 360 of 2019, for upgrades to surveillance  
31 systems at the Harrisburg, Lewisville, Mansfield, Dermott, and Arkansas  
32 Juvenile Assessment and Treatment Center facilities, in a sum not to exceed  
33 .....\$3,700,000.

34 (C) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided  
35 in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 360 of 2019, for improvements to or  
36 replacement of the Sally Port Gate at the Dermott residential facility, in a



1 sum not to exceed .....\$30,000.

2 (D) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided  
3 in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 360 of 2019, for improvements to the road at  
4 the Mansfield residential facility, in a sum not to exceed .....\$50,000.

5 (E) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided  
6 in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 360 of 2019, for the purchase of generators  
7 for the Harrisburg, Lewisville, Mansfield, Dermott, and Arkansas Juvenile  
8 Assessment and Treatment Center facilities, in a sum not to exceed  
9 .....\$480,000.

10 (F) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided  
11 in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 360 of 2019, for the removal of buildings at  
12 the Mansfield and Arkansas Juvenile Assessment and Treatment Center  
13 facilities, in a sum not to exceed .....\$800,000.  
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15 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
16 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
17 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
18 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
19 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
20 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
21 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
22 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
23 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
24 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
25 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
26 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

27 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
28 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
29 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
30 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
31 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
32 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
33 otherwise by law.  
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35 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
36 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
2 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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8 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
9 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
10 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
11 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of  
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
13 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
14 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm  
15 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
16 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
17 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
18 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
