14 AN ACT FOR THE SOUTHEAST ARKANSAS COLLEGE  
15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2015-2016 FISCAL  
16 YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
23 for the Southeast Arkansas College for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the  
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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26 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

27 the Southeast Arkansas College for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the following

28 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra

29 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two hundred

30 (200) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to

31 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or

32 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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34 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby

35 appropriated, to the Southeast Arkansas College, to be payable from the

36 Southeast Arkansas College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses

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17 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
18 to the Southeast Arkansas College, to be payable from cash funds as defined  
19 by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Southeast Arkansas College, for personal  
20 services and operating expenses of the Southeast Arkansas College for the  
21 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the following:

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4 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures

10 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this

11 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

12 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

13 with in disbursement of said funds.

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15 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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24 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

26 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of

28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

29 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

30 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm

31 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

34 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
