26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-8-305 is amended to read as follows:	
29	3-8-305. Elections for entire county, district, or city $-$ Effect.	,
30	(a)(l) No An election in any $\underline{a}$ town, city, district, or precinct	of a
31	county shall <u>not</u> be held under this subchapter on the same day on which	an
32	election for the entire county is held.	
33	(2) (A) When Except as provided in subdivision (a) (2) (B) of	this
34	section, when an election is held in an entire county and a majority of	the
35	legal votes cast at the election $\frac{1}{2}$ against the sale, barter, or load	an of
36	spirituous, vinous, malt, or other intoxicating liquors, then it shall n	not be

1	lawful to sell, barter, or loan any liquors in any portion of the county.	
2	(B) A subsequent election by a town, city, district, or	
3	precinct of a county regarding the sale, barter, or loan of spirituous,	
4	vinous, malt, or other intoxicating liquors is allowed if:	
5	(i) The town, city, district, or precinct of the	
6	county is within a county with more than one (1) county district;	
7	(ii) The town, city, district, or precinct of the	
8	county is directly adjacent to the other intracounty district; and	
9	(iii) The sale, barter, or loan of spirituous,	
10	vinous, malt, or other intoxicating liquors is already lawful within the	
11	other intracounty district.	
12	(3) If, at an election for the entire county, the majority of	
13	the legal votes cast $\frac{1}{2}$ in favor of the sale, barter, or loan of any	
14	liquors, the election shall not operate to make it legal to grant license to	
15	sell, barter, or loan $\frac{1}{2}$ the liquors in $\frac{1}{2}$ territorial division of the	
16	county from which the sale, barter, or loan has been excluded by an election	
17	held under this subchapter, but the status of the territorial division shall	
18	remain as if no election had been held.	
19	(b)(1) No An election shall $\underline{not}$ be held in $\underline{any}$ an election precinct	
20	under this act on the same day on which an election is held for the district	
21	or city of which the precinct is a part.	
22	(2) If, at an election held for the entire district or city, the	
23	majority of legal votes cast $\frac{\text{shall be}}{\text{shall be}}$ in favor of the sale, barter, or	
24	loan of spirituous, vinous, malt, or other liquors, then the status in the	
25	several precincts thereof shall remain as it was before the election.	
26	(3) If the majority should be $is$ against the sale, then the	
27	sale, barter, or loan of such liquors shall be is unlawful in every portion	
28	of the district or city, except in an area in which the sale, barter, or loan	
29	of spirituous, vinous, malt, or other intoxicating liquors has been	
30	authorized under subdivision (a)(2)(B) of this section.
