EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 10 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that in this state the granting of 11 medical licensure to foreign medical graduates is being delayed due to 12 foreign medical graduates having a medical fellowship instead of a medical internship or residency; that a medical fellowship is a period of medical 13 training similar to an internship or residency; that this act would authorize 14 the Arkansas State Medical Board to accept and license foreign medical 15 graduates with fellowships without unnecessary delay; that there is a 16 17 shortage of physicians in certain areas of the State of Arkansas and that the 18 passage of this act will make more physicians available for practice in the 19 State of Arkansas, which is highly desirable for the health care of the 20 citizens of the State of Arkansas; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure that graduates of foreign medical schools who have medical 21 22 fellowships are able to obtain medical licensure when they complete their 23 medical fellowships in the spring of 2019 and to make more physician available for the practice of medicine in this state to improve the health of 24 the citizens of the State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is declared to 25 26 exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the 27 public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on: 28 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 29 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 30 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or 31 32 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 33 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto. 34 35 APPROVED: 3/1/1936

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
