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## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE SOUTHEAST ARKANSAS COLLEGE  
15 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2011-2012 FISCAL  
16 YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
23 for the Southeast Arkansas College for the 2011-2012 fiscal year, the  
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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25 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

26 the Southeast Arkansas College for the 2011-2012 fiscal year, the following

27 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra

28 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two hundred

29 (200) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to

30 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or

31 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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33 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby

34 appropriated, to the Southeast Arkansas College, to be payable from the

35 Southeast Arkansas College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses

36 of the Southeast Arkansas College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012,

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16 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 17 to the Southeast Arkansas College, to be payable from cash funds as defined  
 18 by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Southeast Arkansas College, for personal  
 19 services and operating expenses of the Southeast Arkansas College for the  
 20 fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the following:

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 2 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code, Title 6,  
 3 Chapter 61, Subchapter 5, is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

4 6-61-534. Southeast Arkansas College - Priorities.

5 A high priority of the Southeast Arkansas College is to provide:

- 6 (1) University transfer courses;
- 7 (2) Industrial training in the work place; and
- 8 (3) Encouragement for degree acquisition.

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 10 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 11 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 13 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 16 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 17 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
 18 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
 19 with in disbursement of said funds.

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 21 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 30 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 32 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of  
 34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 35 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 36 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm

upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.

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
