8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 CAREER EDUCATION - ARKANSAS REHABILITATION SERVICES;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CAREER
15 EDUCATION - ARKANSAS REHABILITATION
16 SERVICES REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby
23 appropriated, to the Department of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation
24 Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
25 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Career Education - Arkansas
26 Rehabilitation Services the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 206 of 2013, for major maintenance, renovation,
29 or repair of the Arkansas Career Training Institute water system, in a sum
30 not to exceed.....\$739,110.

31 (B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 206 of 2013, for various maintenance,
33 renovation, equipping, construction, contracting, acquisition, improvement,
34 upgrade and repair of the Arkansas Career Training Institute Armory, in a sum
35 not to exceed.....\$325,890.

36 (C) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided



1 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 206 of 2013, for various maintenance,
2 renovation, equipping, construction, contracting, acquisition, improvement,
3 upgrade and repair of the Arkansas Career Training Institute facility, in a
4 sum not to exceed.....\$149,100.

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6 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL. There is hereby appropriated, to
7 the Department of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services, to be
8 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
9 the State, for the Department of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation
10 Services the following:

11 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
12 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 206 of 2013, for major maintenance, renovation,
13 or repair of the Arkansas Career Training Institute water system, in a sum
14 not to exceed.....\$2,730,890.

15 (B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 206 of 2013, for various maintenance,
17 renovation, equipping, construction, contracting, acquisition, improvement,
18 upgrade and repair of the Arkansas Career Training Institute Armory, in a sum
19 not to exceed.....\$1,204,110.

20 (C) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
21 in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 206 of 2013, for various maintenance,
22 renovation, equipping, construction, contracting, acquisition, improvement,
23 upgrade and repair of the Arkansas Career Training Institute facility, in a
24 sum not to exceed.....\$550,900.

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26 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS - ARKANSAS
27 CAREER TRAINING INSTITUTE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department
28 of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services, to be payable from
29 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
30 Department of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services the
31 following:

32 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 635 of 2013, for various maintenance,
34 renovation, equipping, construction, contracting, acquisition, improvement,
35 upgrade and repair of the Arkansas Career Training Institute facility, in a
36 sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

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2 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
3 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
4 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
5 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
6 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
7 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
8 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
9 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
10 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
11 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
12 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
13 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

14 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
15 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
16 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
17 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
18 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
19 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.
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21 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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30 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
32 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
35 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
36 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm

1 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
2 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
3 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
4 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.

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
