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SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

11 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Department of Workforce

12 <u>Services must ensure the prompt determination of claims for unemployment</u>

13 insurance benefits and the current stabilization tax set aside for the

14 Department of Workforce Services Unemployment Insurance Administration Fund

15 is set to expire on June 30, 2019; that the state's unemployment insurance

16 program must maintain proper authority to process claims for unemployment 17 insurance benefits; and that this act is immediately necessary because a

18 delay would cause a potential service disruption for programs served by the

19 Department of Workforce Services Training Trust Fund and Department of

20 <u>Workforce Services Unemployment Insurance Administration Fund.</u> Therefore, an

21 <u>emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for</u>

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,

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the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
