11 STUDENTS IN ALTERNATIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS; TO
12 ALLOW SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO USE NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH
13 STUDENT STATE OR STATE CATEGORICAL FUNDS FOR
14 CONCURRENT COURSES OR OTHER TECHNICAL EDUCATION
15 ACADEMIC LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES; AND FOR OTHER

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19 TO ALLOW SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO USE CERTAIN
20 CATEGORICAL FUNDS FOR PARTNERSHIPS WITH

22 EDUCATION TO OFFER CONCURRENT COURSES OR
23 OTHER TECHNICAL EDUCATION OPTIONS.
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27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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29 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2305(b)(4)(C)(i)(b)(13), concerning
30 national school lunch "student state" or "state" categorical funds, is
31 amended to read as follows:

32 (13) Partnering with ~~local~~ state-
33 supported institutions of higher education to ~~mediate~~ provide concurrent
34 courses or technical education options for academic learning to students
35 while those students are still in high school so that the students are
36 college and career ready upon graduation from high school;



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SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-48-102(a), concerning alternative learning environments, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(3) Partners with a state-supported institution of higher education to provide concurrent courses or technical education options for academic learning to students in grades eight through twelve (8-12).
