- 2 (3) The establishment and issuance of lifetime hunting licenses
- 3 and lifetime fishing licenses in this state is a small way to recognize and
- 4 honor the service of disabled veterans in this state; and
- 5 (4) It is the purpose and intent of this section to authorize
- 6 and encourage the commission to establish and issue lifetime hunting
- 7 licenses, and lifetime fishing licenses, and lifetime combination hunting and
- 8 fishing licenses for eligible disabled veterans in this state.
- 9 (b) The commission may establish for issuance lifetime hunting and
- 10 <u>licenses</u>, lifetime fishing licenses, and lifetime combination hunting and
- 11 fishing licenses for eligible disabled veterans in this state.
- 12 (c) As used in this section, "disabled veteran" means a veteran who is
- 13 a resident of the state and has either been determined by the United States
- 14 <u>Department of Veterans Affairs to be</u>:
- 15 (1) Been determined by the United States Department of Veterans
- 16 Affairs to be a \underline{A} one hundred percent (100%) totally and permanently disabled
- 17 service-connected veteran; or
- 18 (2) Been determined by the department to be a $\underline{\Lambda}$ permanently
- 19 disabled service-connected veteran who is the recipient of the Purple Heart
- 20 medal as a result of his or her service-connected disability.; or
- 21 (3) For purposes of subsection (f) of this section only, a
- 22 permanently disabled service-connected veteran with a disability rating of
- 23 seventy percent (70%) or higher.
- 24 (d) A disabled veteran may obtain a lifetime license to hunt or a
- 25 lifetime license to fish under this section by:
- 26 (1) Applying to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission
- 27 commission;
- 28 (2) Furnishing information required by the commission to verify
- 29 eligibility; and
- 30 (3) Payment of Paying the following fees:
- 31 (A) One dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) for a lifetime
- 32 hunting license; and
- 33 (B) One dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) for a lifetime
- 34 fishing license.
- 35 (e) A lifetime <u>hunting</u> license, to hunt or a lifetime <u>fishing</u> license,
- 36 to fish or lifetime combination hunting and fishing license issued under this

2	(1) Be in the same form and contain the same information as		
3	other hunting licenses or fishing licenses issued by the commission;		
4	(2) Contain any other information required by the commission;

6	(3) Be plainly stamped either:		
7	(A) "DISABLED VETERAN"; or		
8	(B) "DISABLED VETERAN — PURPLE HEART".		
9	(f) The commission may promulgate such rules and regulations as		
10	necessary to carry out the intent of this section. A disabled veteran may		
11	obtain a lifetime combination hunting and fishing license, which includes a		
12	lifetime trout stamp and a lifetime state duck stamp, under this section by:		
13	(1) Applying to the commission;		
14	(2) Furnishing information required by the commission to verify		
15	eligibility; and		
16	(3) Paying a fee of fifty-two dollars and fifty cents (\$52.50).		
17	(g) The commission may promulgate rules as necessary to implement this		
18	section.
