The Arkansas Industrial and Economic Development Foundation is hereby 23 authorized to make additional payments to the Director of the Arkansas Economic Development 24 Commission, from private funding sources, and upon prior approval from the Arkansas Economic 25 Development Commission, the Arkansas Industrial and Economic Development Foundation, and the 26 Governor. Such additional payments to the Director of the Arkansas Economic Development 27 Commission shall not be considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the 28 maximum salaries established for unclassified employees by the General Assembly. Nothing in this 29 section may be construed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted elsewhere in the Arkansas statute 30 for the payment of allowances or bonuses to unclassified employees. 31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015-2016 through June 30, 2016 32 2017. 33 34 SECTION 45. The Department of Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic Development 28 Commission shall promulgate regulations establishing the criteria to be utilized in determining to whom 29 grants will be made under this Act. Subject to the approval of the Governor, and approval by the 30 Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee, the Department of Rural Services Division of 31 the Arkansas Economic Development Commission shall distribute the grants. 32 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general 33 revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is 34 usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 35 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the 36 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Department of Rural

1 Services Division of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission may operate more efficiently if 2 some flexibility is provided to the Department of Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic 3 Development Commission authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary 4 and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the 5 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval 6 by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the 7 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by 8 a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -2015-2016 through June 30, -2016 10 2017.

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SECTION 55. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 56. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27 SECTION 57. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that 28 the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year 29 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of the agency for 30 which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative 31 session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm upon 32 the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is 33 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, 34 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.

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
