17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-24-206 is amended to read as follows:
20 27-24-206. Fees and limitations.

21 (a)(1) Except as provided in ~~subdivision~~ subdivisions (a)(2) and
22 (b)(2) of this section, special license plates created and issued under this
23 subchapter shall be free of charge to an eligible applicant.

24 (2) To defray the cost of the issuance and renewal of the first
25 special license ~~plates~~ plate under this subchapter, the Director of the
26 Department of Finance and Administration may charge an annual fee for renewal
27 not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00).

28 (b)(1) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a person
29 who is eligible to receive a special license plate under this chapter shall
30 be limited to ~~one (1)~~ two (2) special license ~~plate~~ plates under this
31 subchapter.

32 (2) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a
33 second special license plate under this section shall be issued upon payment
34 of the fee for licensing a motor vehicle.

35 (c) An eligible applicant for the issuance or renewal of any of the
36 following special license plates may obtain one (1) additional special



1 license plate under this subchapter upon payment of a fee not to exceed one
2 dollar (\$1.00):

- 3 (1) Ex-prisoner of War;
- 4 (2) Pearl Harbor Survivor;
- 5 (3) Medal of Honor Recipient;
- 6 (4) Disabled Veteran;
- 7 (5) Disabled Veteran – World War I; or
- 8 (6) Purple Heart Recipient.
