(d) The final average compensation used shall be that of the 13 14 reciprocal system which furnishes the highest final salary at the time of 15 retirement. 16 (c) Wherever this system provides a benefit amount which is not 17 dependent on length of credited service, the benefit amount shall be reduced 18 to the proportion that system-eredited service bears to total reciprocal 19 system-credited service. 20 21 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-10-616 is amended to read as follows: 22 24-10-616. Subjection of benefit rights to legal process. 23 (a)(1) The right of a person to an annuity, the return of accumulated 24 contributions, the annuity itself, any annuity option, any other right 25 accrued or accruing under the provisions of this chapter, and all moneys 26 belonging to a plan shall not be subject to execution, garnishment, 27 attachment, the operation of bankruptcy or insolvency laws, or any other 28 process of law whatsoever and shall be unassignable, except as is specifically provided in this chapter Except as otherwise provided in this 29 30 chapter, the right of a person to an annuity, the return of accumulated contributions, the annuity itself, any annuity option, any other right 31 32 accrued or accruing under this chapter, and all moneys belonging to a plan: 33 (A) Are not subject to: 34 (i) Execution; 35 (ii) Garnishment; 36 (iii) Attachment;

1	(iv) The operation of bankruptcy or insolvency laws;		
2	(v) A qualified domestic relations order, including		
3	a qualified domestic relations order as defined under the Internal Revenue		
4	Code of 1986, 26 U.S.C. § 414; or		
5	(vi) Any claim or process of law; and		
6	(B) Are unassignable.		
7	(2) However, an employer shall have the right of setoff for any		
8	claim arising from embezzlement by, or fraud of, a member, retirant, or		
9	beneficiary.		
10	(b) A final administrative decision of the Board of Trustees of the		
11	Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System may be appealed by filing a		
12	<u>complaint in Pulaski County Circuit Court.</u>		
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14	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-10-706(d)(2), concerning duration of		
15	participation in the Local Police and Fire Deferred Retirement Option Plan,		
16	is amended to read as follows:		
17	(2) All funds in the plan shall be distributed in a manner		
18	prescribed by the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire		
19	Retirement System no later than December 31 of the year the participant		
20	attains the age of seventy and one-half (70 1/2) years April 1 of the year		
21	following the calendar year in which the participant becomes seventy-two (72)		
22	years of age.

24	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
25	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the operations of the Arkansas		
26	Local Police and Fire Retirement System are complex; that the system must be		
27	able to meet the needs of its members; that the statutes concerning		
28	reciprocal service credit, benefit rights, and deferred retirement under the		
29	system are imminently in need of revision and updating to provide clarity and		
30	in order to conform with competent public pension policy; and that this act		
31	is immediately necessary in order to maintain an orderly management of		
32	benefits for the members of the system. Therefore, an emergency is declared		
33	to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public		
34	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on April 1, 2021.		
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
