8	this act provides for the transfer of agricultural boards to the Department
9	of Agriculture for more efficient agricultural promotion and industry in the
10	state; and that this act should become effective on July 1, 2023, to coincide
11	with the appropriation bills of the Department of Agriculture and Department
12	of Finance and Administration to continue to provide the vital services of
13	these state entities as the transfer is implemented and does not experience
14	any issues with funding under the transfer. Therefore, an emergency is
15	declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the
16	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2023.
