- 4 (D) Submit to the Secretary of State a copy of the signed
- 5 statement provided by the paid canvasser under subdivision (d)(3) of this 6 section.
- 7 (3) Upon filing the petition with the Secretary of State, the 8 sponsor shall submit to the Secretary of State a:
- 9 (A) Final list of the names and current residential addresses of each paid canvasser; and
- 11 (B) Signature card for each paid canvasser.

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- (b)(1) To verify that there are no criminal offenses on record, a sponsor shall obtain, at the sponsor's cost, from the Division of Arkansas State Police, a current state and federal criminal record search on every paid canvasser to be registered with the Secretary of State.
- 16 (2) The criminal record search shall be obtained within thirty
  17 (30) days before the date that the paid canvasser begins collecting
  18 signatures.
- 19 (3) Upon submission of the sponsor's list of paid canvassers to
  20 the Secretary of State, the sponsor shall certify to the Secretary of State
  21 that each paid canvasser in the sponsor's employ has passed a criminal
  22 background check in accordance with this section.
- 23 (4) A willful violation of this section by a sponsor or paid
  24 canvasser constitutes a Class A misdemeanor.
  - (b)(1) At least thirty (30) days before the date that a paid canvasser begins collecting signatures, the paid canvasser shall apply to the Division of Arkansas State Police for a state and national criminal background check to be conducted by the division and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 29 (2) Criminal history records from the Arkansas Crime Information
  30 Center shall be available to the Secretary of State for the review of
  31 canvasser qualifications.
- 32 (3) The state and national criminal background check shall 33 conform to applicable federal standards and shall include the taking of 34 fingerprints.
- 35 <u>(4) The paid canvasser shall sign a release of information to</u> 36 <u>the Secretary of State and shall be responsible for the payment of any fee</u>

- 1 associated with the state and national criminal background check.
- 2 (5) Upon the completion of the state and national criminal
- 3 <u>background check</u>, the division shall forward to the Secretary of State all
- 4 releasable information obtained concerning the paid canvasser.
- 5 (6) Upon receipt of all releasable information that has been
- 6 forwarded by the division under subdivision (b)(5) of this section, the
- 7 <u>Secretary of State shall inform the sponsor whether the paid canvasser has</u>
- 8 any disqualifying convictions.
- 9 <u>(7) If a paid canvasser has one (1) or more disqualifying</u>
- 10 convictions, he or she shall not solicit signatures for an initiative or
- 11 <u>referendum petition.</u>
- 12 (c) As used in this section:
- 13 (1) "Disqualifying conviction" means a plea of guilty or nolo
- 14 contendere to or a finding of guilty for a criminal felony offense or a
- 15 violation of the election laws, fraud, forgery, or identification theft in
- 16 any state of the United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam,
- or any other United States protectorate; and
- 18 <u>(2)</u> "paid Paid canvasser" means a person who is paid or with
- 19 whom there is an agreement to pay money or anything of value before or after
- 20 a signature on an initiative or referendum petition is solicited in exchange
- 21 for soliciting or obtaining a signature on a petition.
- 22 (d) Before obtaining a signature on an initiative or referendum
- 23 petition as a paid canvasser, the prospective canvasser shall submit in
- 24 person or by mail to the sponsor:
  - (1) The full name and any assumed name of the person;
- 26 (2) The current residence address of the person and the person's
- 27 permanent domicile address if the person's permanent domicile address is
- 28 different from the person's current residence address;
- 29 (3) A signed statement taken under oath or solemn affirmation
- 30 stating that the person has not pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been
- 31 found guilty of a criminal felony offense or a violation of the election
- 32 laws, fraud, forgery, or identification theft in any state of the United
- 33 States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, or any other United
- 34 States protectorate;

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- $\frac{(4)(3)}{(4)}$  A signed statement that the person has read and
- 36 understands the Arkansas law applicable to obtaining signatures on an

1	initiative or referendum petition; and		
2	(5) (4) A signed statement that the person has been provided a		
3	copy of the most recent edition of the Secretary of State's initiatives and		
4	referenda handbook by the sponsor.		
5	(e) A sponsor shall maintain the information required under this		
6	section for each paid canvasser for three (3) years after the general		
7	election.		
8	(f) Signatures incorrectly obtained or submitted under this section		
9	shall not be counted by the Secretary of State for any purpose.		
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11	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
12	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the power of initiative and		
13	referendum is reserved to the people under Arkansas Constitution, Article 5,		
14	§ 1; that citizens are currently working on initiatives for consideration at		
15	the 2022 elections; that the effects of this act on the qualifications of		
16	paid canvassers impact the initiative and referendum process as the Division		
17	of Arkansas State Police cannot comply with the current requirements of § 7-		
18	9-601 regarding federal background checks; and that the provisions of this		
19	act should become effective as soon as possible to ensure that the statutory		
20	process for background checks of paid canvassers is fully implemented to		
21	protect the public peace, health, and safety by ensuring that paid canvassers		
22	are in compliance with Arkansas law and obtain the statutorily required		
23	background checks. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this		
24	act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,		
25	health, and safety shall become effective on:		
26	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
27	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
28	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
29	bill; or		
30	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
31	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
