36 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARK
2 BUDGET ALLOCATION. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative
3 Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Parks and Tourism
4 Department's plan for the upcoming year of amounts to be disbursed for each
5 park or other entity from the funds appropriated for State Operations of this
6 Act. The request for review from the agency shall include amounts to be
7 disbursed for each entity for the upcoming fiscal year compared to the
8 current fiscal year's anticipated expenditures and the previous fiscal year's
9 actual expenditures with any additional detail as may be required by the
10 reviewing body. The Parks and Tourism Department shall also prepare a
11 semiannual status report for the reviewing body comparing six-month and

17 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
19 MAINTENANCE. The funds appropriated in Section 5 of this Act for Parks and
20 Tourism Special Maintenance shall be expended, after receiving prior approval
21 by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, for a special
22 maintenance program for the Park System. The funds provided will be used for
23 repair and upkeep of parks and museum facilities that have been deferred due
24 to lack of funds in the individual budgets of the parks and museums.
25 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
26 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
27 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
28 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
29 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
30 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
31 has determined that the Department of Parks and Tourism may operate more
32 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Parks and
33 Tourism authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
34 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
35 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
36 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section or
2 the Special Maintenance line item. If the requirement of approval by the
3 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a
4 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section and the Special
5 Maintenance line item in Section 5 is void.

3 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PURCHASE
5 OF UNIFORMS. The Department of Parks and Tourism is hereby authorized to
6 purchase from "Maintenance and General Operations" appropriations provided by
7 this Act, uniforms for Parks personnel, Museum Services personnel, Tourist
8 Information Center personnel, and uniforms and blazers to be used by
9 employees of the Department of Parks and Tourism who are staffing sports
10 shows, travel shows and other special promotional programs and special theme
11 costumes or uniforms for state parks. Provided further, that any clothing
12 purchased under the provisions stated in this section shall remain the
13 property of the Department of Parks and Tourism and shall be surrendered upon
14 request of the Department or upon termination of employment of the individual
15 to whom the clothing was issued.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~

19 SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

21 ATTRACTION FEASIBILITY GRANT PROGRAM. Of the funds appropriated to the
22 Department of Parks and Tourism for grants by Item (05) in Section 3 of this
23 Act, the Department is authorized to make grants to cities and counties on a
24 one to one dollar matching basis, up to \$15,000 in state funds per grant, for
25 the purpose of feasibility studies for tourism attractions. The Department
26 is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the administration of
27 this tourism attraction feasibility grant program. The Department of Parks
28 and Tourism shall notify House and Senate Legislators representing the
29 district of the award recipient.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~

33 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EMPLOYEE
35 CONTRACTS. The Department of Parks and Tourism is hereby authorized to enter
36 into contracts with Department employees for the provision of golf lessons at

1 the Department's golf courses, outside of the employees' normal working
2 hours. Employees shall be Class A members and/or apprentices of the
3 Professional Golfers' Association of America or the Ladies Professional Golf
4 Association. The Director of Arkansas State Parks shall authorize all
5 contracts in accordance with department standards and procedures for
6 concession and operating contracts. Compensation to employees is not
7 retirement eligible.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~

11 SECTION 28. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SMALL
13 FESTIVAL FUNDING. The General Assembly acknowledges the economic benefits of
14 festivals which attract visitors and stimulate the growth of tourism and
15 businesses statewide.

16 Notwithstanding any other provision of law or rules and regulations
17 promulgated by the Department of Parks and Tourism to the contrary, the
18 Department of Parks and Tourism shall dedicate, commit and budget annually
19 one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) from the 2% tourism tax
20 credited to the Tourism Development Trust Fund for expense, advertising,
21 marketing or grants for small festivals in Arkansas communities of less than
22 10,500 people.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~

25
26 SECTION 29. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
27 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
29 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

35
36 SECTION 30. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

1 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
2 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
3 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
4 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
5 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
6 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
7 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8
9 SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
10 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
11 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
14 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
15 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
16 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
17 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
18 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
19 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
