SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 15 ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees, after seeking prior review by the 16 Arkansas Legislative Council, may approve the employment of competent 17 scientists with extraordinary research capabilities to conduct research in 18 the Biomedical Research Center established at the University of Arkansas at 19 Pine Bluff. Further, that the Board of Trustees of the University of 20 Arkansas be authorized to approve salaries for scientists up to, but not to 21 exceed, one and one-half of that portion of the Distinguished Professor line 22 item maximum authorized by the General Assembly to be paid from University of 23 Arkansas at Pine Bluff funds.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013
25 <u>2014</u> through June 30, 2014 <u>2015</u>.

27 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. JENKINS CENTER. Of the funds appropriated in Section 3, the sum of \$252,558 for the 29 30 fiscal year shall be used to provide support to the Jenkins Center in Pine 31 Bluff. Provided, however, such funds shall be used to conduct and maintain a 32 University training program in cooperation with the Jenkins Center. 33 Provided, further, any reductions in funding for appropriation provided in 34 Section 3 shall be proportionately applied to the funds set out herein for 35 support.

SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FORMULA 5 COMPUTATIONS - 1890 MATCHING FUNDS. Any computations made by the Department 6 of Higher Education and the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board in 7 determining levels of recommended funding for the University of Arkansas at 8 Pine Bluff shall include 100% matching funds for the 1890 Research and 9 Extension Programs in the base.

11 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 13 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing and 14 other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of the athletic director, 15 associate/assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches 16 at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, the Board of Trustees may make 17 special allowances available therefore in such amounts as the Board of 18 Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the 19 unusual and exacting duties of said athletic director, associate/assistant 20 athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the purpose 21 of providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend 22 from the auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, which 23 is derived from athletic event receipts. Provided that any such allowances 24 shall be in addition to the regular salary of such athletic director, 25 associate/assistant athletic directors, head coaches and assistant coaches, 26 as established herein provided that the amount of such allowance shall not 27 exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum for any one salaried 28 position. Further, if the special allowance funds authorized herein are 29 utilized the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff shall report annually to 30 the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of those 31 special allowance funds.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201333 2014 through June 30, 2014 2015.

35 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

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1 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 2 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 5 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 6 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 7 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 8 with in disbursement of said funds.

10 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18

19 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 20 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm 25 26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 28 29 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014. 30 31 32 33 34
