30	(B)(i)(a) <u>(1)</u> When a quorum court recei	ves a request for

33	of a volunteer fire dep	artment and filed with the county	clerk, <u>within sixty</u>
34	(60) days of the reques	<u>t</u> the quorum court by ordinance sh	all call for an

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1	(2) The quorum court shall respond in		
2	writing to the volunteer fire department within the sixty-day period under		
3	subdivision (a)(l)(B)(i)(a)(l) of this section if there are issues or		
4	questions the quorum court would like addressed in the request, but in no		
5	event shall the quorum court delay the sixty-day period under subdivision		
6	(a)(l)(B)(i)(a)(l) of this section.		
7	(b)(l) The issue may shall be placed on the		
8	ballot at a special election by order of the quorum court in accordance with		
9	§ 7-11-201 et seq.		
10	(2) The special election shall be held		
11	by August 1.		
12	(c) <u>(l)</u> If an attested petition is filed with		
13	the county clerk and signed by a majority of registered voters in the		
14	volunteer fire department district voting in the immediately preceding		
15	general election, then within sixty (60) days of receipt of the attested		
16	petition the quorum court by ordinance shall dispense with a special election		
17	on the issue of the levy of volunteer fire department dues.		
18	(2) The quorum court shall respond in		
19	writing to the volunteer fire department within the sixty-day period under		
20	subdivision (a)(l)(B)(i)(c)(l) of this section if there are issues or		
21	questions the quorum court would like addressed in the request, but in no		
22	event shall the quorum court delay the sixty-day period under subdivision		
23	<u>(a)(l)(B)(i)(c)(l) of this section.</u>		
24	(d)(l)(A) If the levy of volunteer fire		
25	department dues is approved by a majority of those voting on the issue or the		
26	county clerk determines that the number of signatures of registered voters is		
27	sufficient and the quorum court dispenses with a special election, the		
28	volunteer fire department dues shall be listed annually on <u>beginning with the</u>		
29	next real property tax statements statement and collected by the county		
30	collector at the same time and in the same manner as <u>a prerequisite to the</u>		
31	payment of real property taxes.		
32	(B)(i) The maximum amount of		
33	volunteer fire department dues to be collected by the county as a		
34	prerequisite to the payment of real property taxes is one hundred fifty		
35	dollars (\$150) on each residence and three hundred dollars (\$300) on each		
36	business having an occupiable structure.		

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1	(ii) Volunteer fire
2	department dues that exceed the maximum amounts under subdivision
3	(a)(l)(B)(i)(d)(l)(B)(i) of this section shall be collected by the county
4	collector at the same time and in the same manner as real property taxes but
5	not as a prerequisite to the payment of real property taxes.
6	(2)(A) The county collector shall report
7	delinquencies to the volunteer fire department for collection.
8	(B) A volunteer fire department
9	may collect volunteer fire department dues that have become delinquent and
10	may enforce collection by proceedings in a court of proper jurisdiction.
11	(ii) The cost of the election shall be borne by the
12	volunteer fire department that requested the levy.
13	(2) The ordinance enacted by the quorum court shall set forth
14	the terms and conditions <u>:</u>
15	(A) on On which the volunteer fire department dues are to
16	be collected by the county; and
17	(B) for For the remission of the volunteer fire department
18	dues to the volunteer fire department.
19	(3) However, an active member of a volunteer fire department
20	whose annual volunteer fire department dues are collected in this <u>the</u> manner
21	described in this subsection may be exempt from the annual volunteer fire
22	department dues at the discretion of the volunteer fire department in
23	consideration of providing services to the volunteer fire department.
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
