27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
28		
29	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-42-104(e), concerning special fees for	
30	hunting and fishing licenses for residents, is amended to read as follows:	
31	(e) For this section, the commission may promulgate rules that:	
32	(1) Define "resident" and "totally disabled"; and	
33	(2) Govern the sale and use of each license, permit, or stamp	
34	issued under this section+; and	
35	(3)(A) Allow adjustment for an increase or decrease in the	
36	amount of the maximum fee, also known as the "baseline maximum", for each	

1	resident license, permit, or stamp set forth in subsections (a)-(d) of this
2	section in accordance with the following:
3	(i) Beginning July 1, 2021, each adjusted maximum
4	fee, also known as the "adjusted maximum", shall not exceed sixty-five
5	percent (65%) of the present value of the baseline maximum, as calculated
6	using the Consumer Price Index;
7	(ii) From July 1, 2026, until June 30, 2031, each
8	adjusted maximum may be increased by up to twenty-five percent (25%) of the
9	<u>adjusted maximum previously determined under subdivision (e)(3)(A)(i) of this</u>
10	section; and
11	(iii) On or after July 1, 2031, each adjusted
12	maximum may be increased by up to twenty-five percent (25%) of the adjusted
13	maximum amount previously determined under subdivision (e)(3)(A)(ii) of this
14	section.
15	(B) The commission shall provide a semiannual report to
16	the Game and Fish/State Police Subcommittee of the Legislative Council for
17	administrative review of the total amount of increased fees for resident
18	licenses, permits, or stamps collected as a result of the fee adjustments
19	under subdivision (e)(3)(A) of this section.
20	(f) As used in this section:
21	(1) "Consumer Price Index" means the Consumer Price Index for
22	All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), U.S. City Average, all items, not seasonally
23	adjusted, 1982-1984 equals 100 reference base, as published by the United
24	States Bureau of Labor Statistics; and
25	(2) "Present value" means an amount calculated by multiplying
26	the baseline maximum by a fraction whose numerator is the Consumer Price
27	<u>Index for the month of the proposed adjustment and whose denominator is the</u>
28	Consumer Price Index for the month when the baseline maximum was established
29	or last adjusted.
