20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SCHOOL  
21 FOR MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES AND THE ARTS TEACHER GRANT RELATED FUNDING  
22 PROVISION. Teachers of the School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts  
23 who, in addition to fulfilling annual teaching contract requirements also  
24 write grants, grant progress reports and write and publish papers may be  
25 authorized as additional annual compensation an amount up to 1/10 of their

35 DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES. In order to increase the adult degree completion rate  
36 and to develop its own human capital, the University of Arkansas System is



1 hereby authorized to offer one time lump-sum incentive bonuses or educational  
2 differentials of up to six percent (6%) of the employee's salary for degree  
3 attainment. A bonus or compensation differential may not be authorized if the  
4 education is included as a special requirement or minimum qualification  
5 established for the classification by the official class specification.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014  
7 through June 30, 2015.

8  
9 SECTION 28. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

16 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

20 SECTION 29. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28  
29 SECTION 30. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
30 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
31 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of  
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
35 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm  
36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

1 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
2 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
3 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
