11 2020; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS'  
15 AFFAIRS APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2019-2020  
16 FISCAL YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
23 Department of Veterans' Affairs for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following

 12 appropriated, to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, to be payable from the  
 13 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating

 32 for the Department of Veterans' Affairs - Veterans' Homes for the 2019-2020  
 33 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
 34 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated  
 35 herein for such purposes: thirty (30) temporary or part-time employees, when  
 36 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform

1 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
2 appropriate classification.

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4 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - VETERANS' HOMES. There is hereby  
5 appropriated, to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, to be payable from the

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8 SECTION 6. EXTRA HELP - VETERANS' CEMETERIES - CASH. There is hereby  
 9 authorized, for the Department of Veterans' Affairs - Veterans' Cemeteries -  
 10 Cash for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time  
 11 or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
 12 appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time  
 13 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 14 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act  
 15 for the appropriate classification.

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17 SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - VETERANS' CEMETERIES - CASH. There is  
 18 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, to be payable

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 11 SECTION 9. APPROPRIATION - CEMETERY EXPANSION - FEDERAL. There is  
 12 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, to be payable  
 13 from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
 14 State, for construction and expansion expenses for the North Little Rock  
 15 Veterans' Cemetery of the Department of Veterans' Affairs - Cemetery  
 16 Expansion - Federal for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the following:

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 22 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF  
 24 ADVA CONTINGENCY POSITION POOL AND CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION. In the event  
 25 additional appropriation becomes necessary that is not authorized or  
 26 contemplated in State Operations, Veterans' Homes and Veterans' Cemeteries  
 27 appropriations of this Act and growth in the State Veterans' Home at  
 28 Fayetteville's resident census and/or growth in the number of interments at  
 29 the State Veterans' Cemetery at North Little Rock makes it necessary for the  
 30 Arkansas Department of Veterans' Affairs to request additional positions,  
 31 regular salaries and personal services matching appropriation in order to  
 32 carry out the objectives of the Agency, the ADVA Contingency Position Pool  
 33 and Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be used for regular  
 34 salaries and personal services matching line items.

35 The Arkansas Department of Veterans' Affairs Contingency Appropriation  
 36 authorized herein shall be funded primarily with cash funds of the State

1 Veterans' Home at Fayetteville and of the State Veterans' Cemetery at North  
 2 Little Rock. Each entity's cash funds shall be utilized in support of its own  
 3 business operations and shall not be co-mingled. In addition, general  
 4 revenue funding in support of the ADVA Contingency Position Pool shall be  
 5 limited to \$250,000 per year.

6 Use of the ADVA Contingency Position Pool and Contingency Appropriation  
 7 authorized in this Act shall be conditioned upon approval by the Chief Fiscal  
 8 Officer of the State and upon certification by the Director of the Arkansas  
 9 Department of Veterans' Affairs that funds are available to support the  
 10 contingency positions requested and upon prior review by the Arkansas  
 11 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

12 The General Assembly has determined that the Arkansas State Veterans'  
 13 Home at Fayetteville and the Arkansas State Veterans' Cemetery at North  
 14 Little Rock may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to  
 15 the Arkansas Department of Veterans' Affairs under this Section.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~  
 32 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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 34 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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17 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
18 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
19 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of  
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm  
24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
