20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the 2017-2018 fiscal year,
24 the following maximum number of regular employees.

4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas
 5 Geographic Information Systems Office for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, the
 6 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as
 7 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one
 8 (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
 9 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
 10 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.
 11

12 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 13 to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be payable from the
 14 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating
 15 expenses of the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the fiscal
 16 year ending June 30, 2018, the following:

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 31 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GEOSTOR AND FRAMEWORK. There is hereby
 32 appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be
 33 payable from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, to carry out the
 34 duties, responsibilities and authority of the Arkansas State Land Information
 35 Board as described by Arkansas Code 15-21-504; to create, operate and
 36 maintain Geostor, the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure and to create,

1 update, maintain and disseminate framework spatial data as defined by
2 Arkansas Code 15-21-502 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the

9 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - PARCEL MAPPING GRANT. There is hereby
10 appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be
11 payable from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, for expenses of
12 implementing and administering the Statewide Mapping Grant Program by the
13 Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the fiscal year ending
14 June 30, 2018, the following:

20 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
21 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
23 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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30 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
33 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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3 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
5 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
9 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
10 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
11 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
12 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
13 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
