## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR IN-STATE, IN-COUNTY, INDISTRICT, LOCAL, OR RESIDENT TUITION FOR VETERANS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS, REGARDLESS OF RESIDENCE, AT STATESUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION, TRADE SCHOOLS, OR VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-60-205 is amended to read as follows:
6-60-205. In-state tuition for veterans and military personnel and dependents.

Regardless of residence, a state-supported institution of higher education, trade schools, or vocational schools shall classify a student as in-state, in-county, in-district, local, or resident for the purpose of tuition and fees applicable for all programs of study, including distance learning programs, if the student is a:
(1) Veteran;
(2) Dependent of a veteran;
(3) If a member Member of the armed forces is stationed in the State of Arkansas under military orders, he or she and his or her

unemancipated dependents shall be entitled to classification as "in-state"
for the purpose of paying fees at state-supported colleges and universities;
or

(4) Dependent of a member of the armed forces.
