## Subtitle

14 TO AMEND THE REVENUE STABILIZATION LAW;  
15 TO CREATE FUNDS, TO REPEAL FUNDS, AND TO  
16 MAKE TRANSFERS TO AND FROM FUNDS AND FUND  
17 ACCOUNTS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend the Revenue  
24 Stabilization Law and to create funds, to repeal funds, and to make transfers  
25 to and from funds and fund accounts.  
26

27 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 19-6-  
28 830 is repealed.

30 ~~(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of~~  
31 ~~State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special revenue fund to be~~  
32 ~~known as the "Skills Development Fund".~~

4 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 19,  
5 Chapter 5, Subchapter 12, is amended to add an additional section to read as  
6 follows:

7 19-5-1267. Skills Development Fund.

8 (a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of  
9 State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous fund to be  
10 known as the "Skills Development Fund".

11 (b) The fund shall consist of:

12 (1) General revenues authorized by law;

13 (2) Moneys obtained from private grants or other sources that are  
14 designated to be credited to the fund; and

15 (3) Any other revenues authorized by law.

16 (c) The fund shall be used by the Office of Skills Development as provided  
17 in § 25-30-109.

18  
19 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 19-5-401 is amended to read as follows:

20 19-5-401. Allocations for fiscal year 2020-2021 and thereafter.

21 Commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and each fiscal year  
22 thereafter, the Treasurer of State shall transfer all remaining general  
23 revenues available for distribution on the last day of business in July 2020,  
24 and on the last day of business in each calendar month thereafter during the  
25 fiscal year to the various funds and fund accounts participating in general  
26 revenues in the proportions of the maximum allocation as the individual  
27 allocation to the fund or fund account bears to the total of the maximum  
28 allocation as provided in § 19-5-402 (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e).

29  
30 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 19-5-402 is amended to read as follows:

31 19-5-402. Maximum allocations of revenues for fiscal year 2020-2021 and  
32 thereafter.

33 (a)(1)(A) ALLOCATION A. The Treasurer of State shall first make monthly  
34 allocations in the proportions set out in this subsection to the funds and  
35 fund accounts listed below until there has been transferred a total of five  
36 billion two hundred sixty-one million one hundred eighty three thousand seven

1 hundred and eight dollars (\$5,261,183,708) or so much thereof as may become  
 2 available; provided, that the Treasurer of State shall make such monthly  
 3 allocations in accordance with each fund or fund account's proportionate part  
 4 of the total of all such allocations set forth in this subsection:

1 in subsection (a)(1)(A) and (a)(2)(A) of this section, the Treasurer of State  
 2 shall then make allocations from the remaining general revenues available for  
 3 distribution, as set forth in this subsection, to the funds and fund accounts  
 4 listed below until there has been transferred a total of one hundred eighty-  
 5 four million three hundred fifty five thousand five hundred forty six dollars  
 6 (\$184,355,546) or so much thereof that may become available; provided, that  
 7 the Treasurer of State shall make such monthly allocations in accordance with  
 8 each fund or fund account's proportionate part of the total of all such  
 9 allocations set forth in this subsection:

9 SECTION 6. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED  
10 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DUPLICATE ACTS. If HB1096  
11 and SB83 of the 2020 Fiscal Session of the 92<sup>nd</sup> General Assembly are both  
12 enacted and adopted by the 92<sup>nd</sup> General Assembly in identical form, then the  
13 last Act passed or latest expression shall supersede the other.

14  
15 SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,  
16 2020.

17  
18 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
19 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that changes in the state's fiscal  
20 laws must take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year; and that it is  
21 necessary for this act to become effective on July 1, 2020, to avoid a lapse  
22 in critical and essential services that state government provides to the  
23 citizens of this state at the beginning of the next fiscal year. Therefore,  
24 an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the  
25 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective  
26 on July 1, 2020.
