| 5 | SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. INVESTMENTS. All such funds as are held |
| 6 | at any time in the Death and Permanent Total Disability Trust Fund, Second |
| 7 | Injury Trust Fund, and the Workers' Compensation Fund shall be invested and |
| 8 | reinvested to the extent feasible, all such investments as authorized for use |
| 9 | by the Office of the Treasurer shall be available to the listed funds. The |
| 10 | movement of these funds into and out of investments shall be by fund |
| 11 | transfers as directed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Workers' |

     programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

     being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

     and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
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
