16	TO DESIGNATE MARCH 2023 AS RARE KIDNEY
17	DISEASE AWARENESS MONTH IN ARKANSAS TO
18	INCREASE PUBLIC AWARENESS AND

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22	WHEREAS, March is nationally recognized as National Kidney Month and
23	this recognition is an important opportunity to raise public awareness and
24	understanding of rare kidney diseases, such as APOLI-mediated kidney disease;
25	and
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27	WHEREAS, APOL1 genetic variants account for much of the excess risk of
28	chronic and end-stage kidney disease for persons of African ancestry,
29	including people of African American, Afro-Caribbean, and Latin descent; and
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31	WHEREAS, APOL1 explains the disproportionate rate of kidney disease in
32	people of African ancestry as African Americans make up thirteen percent
33	(13%) of the United States population, but account for thirty-two percent
34	(32%) of all kidney failure and thirty-five percent (35%) of all end stage
35	kidney disease; and
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1	WHEREAS, African Americans are four (4) times more likely to develop
2	kidney failure than White Americans; and
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4	WHEREAS, APOLI-mediated kidney disease is driven by genetic factors and
5	is underdiagnosed; and
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7	WHEREAS, symptoms do not present until kidney damage is advanced and
8	symptoms include fatigue, swelling in the legs and feet, and weight gain; and
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10	WHEREAS, increasing public awareness and understanding of the genetic
11	causes of rare kidney disease could lead to early diagnosis and care for some
12	of the most vulnerable populations and empower and educate those at risk on
13	how they can manage it,
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15	NOW THEREFORE,
16	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
17	STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
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19	THAT the Senate, with the House of Representatives concurring,
20	designate March 2023 as Rare Kidney Disease Awareness Month in Arkansas.
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
