30	THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of

- SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 5, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 § 5. Regular and <u>fiscal</u> <u>special</u> sessions.
- 4 (a) The General Assembly shall meet at the seat of government every 5 year.
- 6 (b)(1) The General Assembly shall meet in regular session on the
  7 second Monday in January of each odd-numbered year to consider any bill or
  8 resolution.
- 9 <u>(2)</u> The General Assembly may alter the time at which the regular session begins.
- 11 (c)(1) Beginning in 2010, the General Assembly shall meet in fiscal
  12 session on the second Monday in February of each even-numbered year to
  13 consider only appropriation bills. The General Assembly may alter the time
  14 at which the fiscal session begins.
- 15 (2) A bill other than an appropriation bill may be considered in 16 a fiscal session if two-thirds (2/3) of the members of each house of the 17 General Assembly approve consideration of the bill.
- (d) The General Assembly, by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members
  elected to each house of the General Assembly, may alter the dates of the
  regular session and fiscal session so that regular sessions occur in even
  numbered years and the fiscal sessions occur in odd-numbered years.
- 22 <u>(c)(1) The General Assembly may convene in special session upon the</u> 23 <u>submission of a petition containing:</u>
- 24 <u>(A) The written signatures of a majority of the members of</u>
  25 <u>the House of Representatives to the Chief Clerk of the House of</u>

- 27 <u>(B) The written signatures of a majority of the members of</u> 28 the Senate to the Secretary of the Senate.

- 31 (3)(A) If the petitions under subdivision (c)(1) of this section 32 are found to contain the signatures of a majority of the members of each

12	SECTION 2. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 17, is amended to read
13	as follows:
14	§ 17. Duration of sessions.
15	(a)(1) A regular biennial session shall not exceed sixty (60) thirty
16	(30) calendar days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-thirds $(2/3)$
17	of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly. The regular
18	biennial session shall not exceed seventy five (75) calendar days in
19	duration, unless extended by a vote of three-fourths (3/4) of the members
20	elected to each house of the General Assembly.
21	(2) In no event shall a regular session exceed sixty (60)
22	calendar days in duration.
23	(b) A fiscal session shall not exceed thirty (30) calendar days in

30	SECTION 3. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 18, is amended to read

33	Each house, at the beginning of every regular session of the General
34	Assembly following a general election, and whenever a vacancy may occur,
35	shall elect from its members a presiding officer, to be styled, respectively,
36	the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

1 and whenever, at the close of any session, it may appear that the term of the 2 member elected President of the Senate will expire before the next regular session, the Senate shall elect another President from those members whose 3 4 terms of office continue over, who shall qualify and remain President of the 5 Senate until his successor may be elected and qualified; and who, in the case 6 of a vacancy in the office of Governor, shall perform the duties and exercise 7 the powers of Governor as elsewhere herein provided. 8 9 SECTION 4. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 34, is amended to read 10 as follows: 11 § 34. Introduction of bills - Time limit. 12 No new bill shall be introduced into either house during the last three 13 days of a regular or fiscal session. 14 15 SECTION 5. Arkansas Constitution, Article 5, § 42(b), concerning the 16 review and approval of administrative rules by a legislative committee, is 17 amended to read as follows: 18 (b) The review and approval by a legislative committee under 19 subsection (a) of this section may occur during the interim or during a 20 regular, or special, or fiscal session of the General Assembly. 21 22 SECTION 6. Nothing in this amendment shall be construed to alter the 23 Governor's authority to call a special session of the General Assembly. 24 25 SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This amendment is effective on and after 26 January 1, 2021. 27 SECTION 8. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. When this proposed 28 29 amendment is submitted to the electors of this state on the general election 30 ballot: 31 (1) The title of this Joint Resolution shall be the ballot 32 title; and 33 (2) The popular name shall be "An Amendment to the Arkansas
