21	WHEREAS, Gregory Brian Standridge, born on May 6, 1967, in
22	Russellville, Arkansas, to the late Marvin J. Standridge and Jewel Simcox,
23	died on November 16, 2017, at the age of fifty (50) years following a long
24	and courageous battle with cancer; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, Senator Standridge attended Arkansas Tech University, worked
27	as a licensed insurance agent, and was a co-owner of CSI Insurance Agency in
28	Russellville, founded in 2010; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, Senator Standridge served as a past-president of both the
31	Independent Insurance Agents of Arkansas (2012-2013) and the Professional
32	Insurance Agents of Arkansas (1998-1999) and served on the Pope County 911
33	Board, the Workforce Investment Board, the Pope County Fair Board, and as a
34	constable in Pope County, Arkansas; and

36	WHEREAS, Senator Standridge was active with the Pope County Emergency



1 Services Rescue Unit and became a volunteer fire fighter in September of 1989 2 with the Crow Mountain Fire Department, later serving as Chief from January 3 2012 until February 2015; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Senator Standridge was elected to the Arkansas State Senate 6 after winning a special election in 2015 and served as the Assistant Pro 7 Tempore for the 3rd Congressional District for the Ninety-First General 8 Assembly until his passing; he served as Cochair of the Rural Fire 9 Departments Study Committee; and during his tenure in the General Assembly, 10 he was a member of the Senate Committee on Transportation, Technology and 11 Legislative Affairs, the Senate Committee on City, County and Local Affairs, 12 the Senate Interim Committee on Children and Youth, the Arkansas State Game 13 and Fish Commission Oversight Committee, the Legislative Task Force on 14 Intermodal Transportation and Commerce, the Joint Committee on Economic and 15 Tax Policy, and the Boys State Committee; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Senator Standridge also recognized the importance of working 18 with other legislators across the United States and served in the Southern 19 Legislative Conference (SLC), the National Conference of State Legislatures 20 (NCSL), the Council of State Governments (CSG), and the American Legislative 21 Exchange Council (ALEC); and he was a member of the SLC Agriculture and Rural 22 Development Committee, the NCSL Labor and Economic Development Standing 23 Committee, the CSG Energy and Environmental Public Policy Task Force, and the 24 ALEC Commerce, Insurance and Economic Development Task Force; and 25 26 WHEREAS, Senator Standridge was a long-time member of First Baptist 27 Church of Russellville, serving as head of the security team; he was an avid lover of golf; and he enjoyed spelunking, camping, cooking, water sports, 28 29 scuba diving, traveling, and spending time with many family and friends; and 30 31 WHEREAS, Senator Standridge was a member of the Russellville Lions 32 Club, the Russellville Masonic Lodge, and the London Masonic Lodge, and was 33 the recipient of numerous awards for his professional and volunteer 34 achievements; and 35

WHEREAS, Senator Standridge left to cherish his memory his wife of
