21	WHEREAS, born August 4, 1960, in Perry, Florida, to the late Reverend
22	Arthur L. Mitchell, Sr. and the late Mrs. Mary L. Mitchell, Bishop Michael
23	Leon Mitchell is the ninth of fifteen (15) children; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, while in high school, Bishop Mitchell answered the call to the
26	ministry and preached his trial sermon at seventeen (17) years of age, on
27	August 28, 1977, at New Saint James African Methodist Episcopal Church in
28	Jacksonville, Florida; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, Bishop Mitchell began his ministerial training and study under
31	the African Methodist Episcopal Church and was ordained an Itinerant Deacon
32	in 1979 and an Itinerant Elder in 1981; and
33	
34	Whereas, Bishop Mitchell's first pastoral assignment came in 1985 at
35	the African Methodist Episcopal Church of the Master in Jacksonville,
36	Florida, and he also pastored Greater Mount Zion African Methodist Episcopal



1 Church in Arcadia, Florida, Saint Luke African Methodist Episcopal Church in 2 Tampa, Florida, and Martin Memorial African Methodist Episcopal Church in 3 Miami, Florida; and 4 WHEREAS, in September 1992, Bishop Mitchell was chosen to succeed 5 6 Bishop Robert V. Webster as pastor of Saint Stephen African Methodist 7 Episcopal Church in Jacksonville, Florida, where he served the congregation 8 and community faithfully for twenty-four (24) years; and 9 10 WHEREAS, Bishop Mitchell married Supervisor Cordelia Mitchell, the only 11 child of Ms. Alice Rowe and the late Mr. John May; and 12 WHEREAS, Bishop Mitchell was elected and consecrated in 2016 as the 13 14 134th Bishop of the African Methodist Episcopal Church at the 50th 15 Quadrennial Session of the General Conference in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; 16 and 17 18 WHEREAS, in 2016, Bishop Mitchell and Supervisor Mitchell were also 19 assigned as the Episcopal Leaders of the 12th Episcopal District of the 20 African Methodist Episcopal Church which encompasses Arkansas and Oklahoma; 21 and 22 23 WHEREAS, Bishop Mitchell aided the leadership of the 12th Episcopal 24 District of the African Methodist Episcopal Church to complete projects begun 25 by his predecessors while Supervisor Mitchell supported the ministries of the 26 church by working with and mentoring youth, promoting health and education, 27 and ministering to incarcerated women; and 28 29 WHEREAS, Bishop Mitchell is actively involved in the social, economic, 30 and educational needs of the community by serving on the Economic Recovery Task Force Committee in Arkansas, as the Chair of the Board of Trustees of 31 32 Shorter College and Jackson Theological Seminary, and as First Vice President 33 of Turner Theological Seminary Board of Trustees; and 34 35 WHEREAS, Supervisor Mitchell is actively involved in many

organizations, including Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., The Bold City

Chapter of The Links, Inc., the Society for Human Resource Management, National Alumni Association of Spelman College, the Society for Human Resource Management, and the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People; and WHEREAS, as true servant leaders, Bishop Mitchell and Supervisor Mitchell possess a heart for the parish and the people which deserves to be honored, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: THAT the Senate honor Bishop Michael Mitchell and Supervisor Cordelia Mitchell for their service to the 12th Episcopal District of the African Methodist Episcopal Church.
