30 2001-2003 and 2015-2019; and

33 Assembly of the State of Arkansas and is well known for his fiery speeches
34 from the well, no matter who opposed him; and

36 WHEREAS, Mr. Hendren has been married to his wife, the former Marylea



1 Hutchinson, for 51 years, raising their 4 children in the church where Mr.
2 Hendren was a leader and elder for over 40 years; and

5 of Arkansans, whether it was passing school bus safety and educational laws
6 or any of the many other actions he took that benefited the future of the
7 state,
