15 WHEREAS, the administration of President Donald Trump and the federal
16 government are dealing with a humanitarian and security crisis at the
17 southern border of the United States; and

19 WHEREAS, the crisis has a negative effect on southern states, including
20 Arkansas, with problems generated by illegal crossings, crime, and drug
21 trafficking, especially deadly drugs like fentanyl; and

23 WHEREAS, the Arkansas congressional delegation, Governor Asa
24 Hutchinson, Lieutenant Governor Tim Griffin, and Attorney General Leslie
25 Rutledge support increased funding for border security and an extension of
26 the border wall, a subject currently being debated in Washington, D.C.; and

28 WHEREAS, the individuals of United States Immigration and Customs
29 Enforcement and United States Customs and Border Protection continue to work
30 hard to uphold the rule of law, ensure our safety, and protect the national
31 security; and

33 WHEREAS, the debate has caused a shutdown of the federal government, a
34 contentious battle on the government budget, and a showdown over how much
35 will be allocated for border security within the budget, and is negatively
36 impacting the lives of Arkansans who rely on federal government services,
