- 12 (a) Support the people of the sovereign nation of Ukraine and condemn 13 the actions of the Russian Federation taken against the sovereign nation of 14 Ukraine;
 - (b) Call for the United States to expel Russian oligarchs, freeze assets of Russian oligarchs and political leaders who supported the invasion of the sovereign nation of Ukraine, and take other similar actions that would deter the Russian Federation from further unprovoked aggression towards its neighbors and to penalize the Russian Federation for its unjust invasion of the sovereign nation of Ukraine;
- 21 (c) Call for the United States to place sanctions on Russian oil and 22 other natural resources; and
