HB 2397: emotional abuse; vulnerable adults Sponsor: Representative Dunn, LD 13 Committee on Health & Human Services

Overview

Expands the definition of abuse to include emotional abuse and defines emotional abuse.

<u>History</u>

In 2019, the Speaker of the House of Representatives established the House Ad Hoc Committee on Abuse and Neglect of Vulnerable Adults (Committee). The purpose of the Committee was to review and identify best practices for the reporting and investigative processes to ensure the safety of vulnerable adults. One of the recommendations in the Committee's <u>final report</u> was to create a statutory definition of *emotional abuse* in Title 46 of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

Abuse is currently defined as: 1) intentional infliction of physical harm; 2) injury caused by negligent acts or omissions; 3) unreasonable confinement; or 4) sexual abuse or sexual assault (A.R.S. § 46-451).

Provisions

- 1. Adds emotional abuse to the definition of abuse. (Sec. 1)
- 2. Defines *emotional abuse* as a pattern of ridiculing or demeaning a vulnerable adult, making derogatory remarks to a vulnerable adult, verbally harassing a vulnerable adult or threatening to inflict physical or emotional harm on a vulnerable adult. (Sec. 1)
- 3. Makes conforming changes. (Sec. 1)
