Overview

Continues the State Personnel Board (SPB) for four years.

History

SPB is tasked with hearing and reviewing appeals relating to dismissal of employees from covered state service, suspension for more than 80 working hours or involuntary demotion that resulted from disciplinary action ([A.R.S. § 41-782](#)).

The House Government Committee of Reference met on January 10, 2024 to hear a sunset review on SPB. The House Government Committee of Reference recommended that SPB be continued for four years.

Provisions

1. Continues, retroactive to July 1, 2024, SPB until July 1, 2028. (Sec. 2, 4)
2. Repeals SPB on January 1, 2029. (Sec. 2)
3. Contains a purpose statement. (Sec. 3)

Amendments

Committee on Government

1. Continues, retroactive to July 1, 2024, SPB until July 1, 2032.
2. Repeals SPB on January 1, 2033.
