# FACT SHEET FOR H.B. 2700

## county officers; salaries; increase

## Purpose

Increases, beginning January 1, 2025, the salary of county attorneys, assessors, recorders, sheriffs, superintendents of schools, supervisors and treasurers by \$20,000.

### **Background**

Statue outlines annual salaries for elected county officers. For counties with a population of 500,000 or more persons, the annual salaries of the county assessor, recorder, superintendent of schools, supervisors and treasurer are \$76,600. For counties with a population of fewer than 500,000 persons, the annual salaries of the county assessor, recorder, superintendent of schools, supervisors and treasurer are \$63,800. The salary for a county attorney is \$123,678 and the salary of a county sheriff is \$100,824 (A.R.S. § 11-419).

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the state General Fund associated with this legislation.

## Provisions

- 1. Increases, effective January 1, 2025, the annual salary of the following elected county officers by \$20,000:
  - a) for county attorneys, from \$123,678 to \$143,678;
  - b) for county sheriffs, from \$100,824 to \$120,824;
  - c) for county assessors, recorders, superintendents of schools, supervisors and treasurers in a county with a population of 500,000 or more persons, from \$76,600 to \$96,600; and
  - d) for county assessors, recorders, superintendents of schools, supervisors and treasurers in a county with a population less than 500,000 persons, from \$63,800 to \$83,800.
- 2. Makes technical and conforming changes.
- 3. Becomes effective on the general effective date.
