PURPOSE: Adds \$4.9 million cash funds from the Revenue Loss Restoration Cash Fund, which originate as federal funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), for the Behavioral Health Continuum Gap Grant and Behavioral Health-care Provider Workforce Plan in the Department of **Human Services** and adds a footnote specifying the General Assembly's intent that the increase support behavioral health services in rural areas of the state.
