9 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (3) DOES NOT APPLY IN THE EVENT OF AN 10 EMERGENCY COVERED BY RULES PROMULGATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF 11 PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT IF SUCH EMERGENCY AFFECTS THE 12 PHYSICAL SPACE OF THE FACILITY AND NECESSITATES THE REMOVAL OF 13 CLIENTS, EMPLOYEES, OR CONTRACTORS FROM THE FACILITY.".

Page 28, line 20, strike "SECTION, "MATERNAL HEALTH-CARE" and 15 substitute "SECTION: 16
