1 Amend printed bill, page 2, after line 27, insert:

"SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-8-115, amend (3)(c) as follows:

by reason of insanity or not guilty by reason of impaired mental condition. (3) (c) A defendant who has been conditionally released remains under the supervision of the department of human services until the committing court enters a final order of unconditional release. When a defendant fails to comply with any conditions of his release requiring him to establish, maintain, and reside at a specific residence and his whereabouts have therefore become unknown to the authorities charged with his supervision or when the defendant leaves the state of Colorado without the consent of the committing court, the defendant's absence from supervision shall constitute escape UNAUTHORIZED ABSENCE, as defined in section 18-8-208, C.R.S. 18-8-208.2. Such offense occurs in the county in which the defendant is authorized to reside."

- Page 3, line 15, strike "(1)(f.5)(I)" and substitute "(1)(f.5)(I), (2)(c)(I),".
- 19 Page 3, after line 25 insert:
 - "(2) (c) (I) If a defendant is convicted of assault in the second degree pursuant to paragraph (c.5) of subsection (1) of this section or paragraph (b.5) of this subsection (2) SUBSECTION (2)(b.5) OF THIS SECTION, except with respect to sexual assault or sexual assault in the first degree as it existed prior to July 1, 2000, the court shall sentence the defendant in accordance with the provisions of section 18-1.3-406. A defendant convicted of assault in the second degree pursuant to paragraph (b.5) of this subsection (2) with respect to sexual assault or sexual assault in the first degree as it existed prior to July 1, 2000, shall be sentenced in accordance with section 18-1.3-401 (8)(e) or (8)(e.5)."
