HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.

HB22-1317 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 5, line 14, after "(5)" insert "(a)".

2 Page 5, strike lines 24 through 27.

3 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 7 and substitute:

4 "(b) Notwithstanding ~~subsection (3)(a)~~ SUBSECTION (5)(a) of this
5 section, after termination of an agreement described in ~~subsection (3)(a)~~
6 SUBSECTION (5)(a) of this section, a physician may disclose his or her
7 continuing practice of medicine and new professional contact information
8 to any patient with a rare disorder, as defined in accordance with criteria
9 developed by the National Organization for Rare Disorders, Inc., or a
10 successor organization, to whom the physician was providing consultation
11 or treatment before termination of the agreement. Neither the physician
12 nor the physician's employer, if any, is liable to any party to the prior
13 agreement for damages alleged to have resulted from the disclosure or
14 from the physician's treatment of the patient after termination of the prior
15 agreement."

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
