  - (II) IF THE ALLEGATION IS SUBSEQUENTLY FOUND NOT SUSTAINED OR IF THE PEACE OFFICER IS EXONERATED, THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL NOTIFY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY'S JURISDICTION OF THE FINDING AND THE
- 24 CREDIBILITY DISCLOSURE NOTIFICATION BASED ON THE ALLEGATION MUST
- 25 BE REMOVED FROM THE RELEVANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S CREDIBILITY
- 26 DISCLOSURE NOTIFICATION RECORD.".
