## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

#### J.001

Staff amendment **J.001** (attached) appropriates a total of \$50,421 to the Department of Human Services for FY 2025-26, including \$43,866 General Fund. The appropriation reflects 0.5 FTE and the anticipated receipt of \$6,555 federal funds.

#### L.007

Bill Sponsor amendment **L.007** (attached) removes the template and training compliance monitoring requirements. Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that the amendment removes the fiscal impact of the bill.

If the Committee adopts L.007, it should not adopt J.001.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### **General Fund Impact**

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2025-26 based on the March 2025 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$18.2 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders.

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$43,866 for FY 2025-26, reducing the \$18.2 million set aside by the same amount. The General Fund impact is removed if the Committee adopts **L.007**.
