The fiscal note reflects General Fund expenditures of \$75,293 for FY 2021-22, including \$71,529 to the Department of Public Health and Environment and \$3,764 to the Legislative Department. The \$3,764 identified as expenditures to the Legislative Department are directly related to per diem reimbursement costs for members of the legislature serving on the newly created Kidney Disease Prevention and Education Task Force. Section 25-1-131 (5), C.R.S., specifically states that "each member of the task force serves without compensation, and a member is not entitled to reimbursement for any expenses associated with serving on the task force."

# **Points to Consider**

## General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package includes a set aside of \$50.0 million General Fund for bills that require General Fund appropriations for FY 2021-22. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$71,529 for FY 2021-22, reducing the \$50.0 million set aside by the same amount.
