Sunset bill. The bill continues the Senior Dental Advisory Committee, scheduled to be repealed September 1, 2024, for five years. It minimally increases state workload.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill continues the Senior Dental Advisory Committee in the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) for five years through September 1, 2029.

Continuing Program Impacts

HCPF operates the Senior Dental Advisory Committee with no specific appropriation. If the bill is enacted, HCPF will continue to have a minimal workload impact to support the committee. The sunset report on the committee by the Department of Regulatory Agencies is available [here](#).

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
