## HB 21-1262

### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill creates the Agricultural Events Relief Program in the Department of Agriculture (CDA) to provide COVID-19 relief payments to agricultural events organizations and provides funding for the Colorado State Fair and National Western Stock Show. The CDA is authorized to spend up to \$100,000 to administer the relief program or contract with a third-party. The Commissioner of Agriculture will develop eligibility criteria and report on the program at the CDA SMART Act hearing. The bill makes \$9.0 million in appropriations for FY 2020-21, that are further appropriated for FY 2021-22.

#### **State Transfers**

The bill transfers \$3.5 million from the General Fund to the Colorado State Fair Authority Cash Fund in FY 2020-21.

#### **State Expenditures**

The bill will increase expenditures for the CDA by \$9.0 million between FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 to provide relief to agricultural events organizations, and to fund the state fair and National Western Stock Show. The CDA will conduct a stakeholder process to inform the Commissioner's development of eligibility criteria. The funding for the National Western Stock Show will help them cover losses and the funding for the State Fair will likely be used for maintenance and projects.

#### **Local Government**

Local county fairs that are awarded grants by the CDA will have an increase in expenditures.

### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.

### **State Appropriations**

For FY 2020-21, the bill appropriates to the Department of Agriculture:

- \$5.5 million from the General Fund; and
- \$3.5 million from the Colorado State Fair Authority Cash Fund.
