Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$9,000,000 to the Department of Agriculture for FY 2020-21, including \$5,500,000 General Fund and \$3,500,000 cash funds from the Colorado State Fair Authority Cash Fund. The provision also makes any funds that remain unspent at the end of FY 2020-21 available to the Department for FY 2021-22.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package \$5,500,000 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill. Specifically, the JBC package includes a place holder of \$800.0 million General Fund for those bills that are part of the "State Stimulus Package", and this bill is part of that package.
